### **Membership Requirements**

1. Regular Membership:  
Any individual appointed or hired full or part-time by any governmental organization actively performing urban and community forestry activities, including administration, research and education; and individuals, either actively or not actively engaged in the practice of urban and community forestry, whose associated profession or interest supports the purposes of the association.
2. Affiliate Membership:  
Individuals or firms who manufacture of supply products utilized in the practice of arboriculture or who reside outside the State of North Dakota and who, by the affiliation, wish to support the association.
3. Student Membership:  
Students enrolled in Arboriculture, Urban Forestry, Horticulture, Forestry, Landscape Architecture, or other related fields as determined by approval of the regular membership.

### **NDUCFA Code of Ethics**

1. To further the science and practice of professional arboriculture by subscribing to and maintaining high ethical standards among the members.
2. To stimulate great public interest on the planting and preservation of shade and ornamental trees.
3. To encourage the practice of urban forestry in the state of North Dakota.
